Regular Meeting 45th LD

Matthew, gave a report on the status of Eric Oemig's campaign

Mike Burner gave a report on the status of Darcy Burner's campaign, stating a number of polls show a very positive response. Early voters are voting heavily for Darcy.

Roger Goodman gave a report on the status of his campaign and his recent doorbelling in Carnation. He has received very positive feedback from his recent doorbelling and is cautiously optimistic. He has doorbelled approximately 11,000 doors personally.

Andrew gave a report on the recent Obama / Cantwell / Burner rally. About 3000 people were there.

The effect of this change is that any resident member of the LD organization may run for and be elected to any office. (The restriction that only elected PCOs may vote for officers still applies.)
